On December 12, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by James A. Meyer, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated November 10, 1998. A request was also made that the board allow Meyer to open and/or close the pharmacy as pharmacist-in-charge one or two days per week and open and close the pharmacy on a weekend day.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that James A. Meyer, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #11446 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the *Order* is modified to allow Meyer to open the pharmacy as pharmacist-in-charge during the weekday, subject to Meyer's current pharmacist-in-charge limitations set by the board's June 14, 2000 order, (8 hours per week acting as a pharmacist in charge, with no more than 4 consecutive hours).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Meyer shall not petition the board for any further modifications of the *Order* for six (6) months following the date of this order.
