ORDER GRANTING
STAY OF SUSPENSION
AND MODIFICATION OF FINAL ORDER

On June 14, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by James A. Meyer, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated November 10, 1998. A request was also made that the board increase Meyer's hours as pharmacist-in-charge in an amount to be left to the board's discretion, and that he be allowed to open or close the pharmacy as pharmacist-in-charge.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that James A. Meyer, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #11446 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. The request for an increase in the number of allowable hours as pharmacist-in-charge is granted with an increase to a total of 8 hours per week acting as a pharmacist in charge, with no more than 4 consecutive hours. The request for a modification to allow opening or closing the pharmacy, is denied.

Please be advised that the submission of the next quarterly reports and petition for extension of stay of suspension are due on September 1, 2000.
