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ORDER GRANTING FULL LICENSURE

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On March 5, 1999, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for not less than one year. The Order specified that respondent could petition at any time for a stay of the suspension upon submission of proof that she is participating in an acceptable treatment program, and submission of an evaluation establishing that she may safely and reliably practice as a professional nurse. Also on March 5, 1999, the board considered Ms. Britton's request that the suspension of her license be stayed. The board granted the request by its Order dated March 8, 1999.

On March 3, 2000, the board considered Ms. Britton's request that the limitations on her license be terminated, and that she be reinstated to full licensure. Based upon evidence that Ms. Britton has complied with the limitations on her license for the requisite period of time, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Cheryl L. Britton, RN., to practice as a professional nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Britton is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
