ORDER GRANTING
STAY OF SUSPENSION
(MARCH, 2000)

On March 15, 2000 the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by William Karwoski, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, and a reduction in the once weekly Individual/Group Therapy requirement, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated March 10, 1999. Karwoski additionally claims that he remains unemployed as a pharmacist.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that William Karwoski, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #9334 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. The request for a reduction in the once weekly Individual/Group Therapy requirement, as required by the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated March 10, 1999, is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Karwoski shall hereafter until further notice from the board participate in Individual/Group Therapy two (2) times per month until such time as he obtains employment as a pharmacist, whereupon he shall immediately notify the board of such fact of employment and resume once weekly Individual/Group Therapy.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects, the previous orders of the board in this matter remain in full force and effect.

Please be advised that the submission of the next quarterly reports and petition for extension of stay of suspension are due on June 1, 2000.
