On July 16, 1999, the Funeral Directors Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. The Board issued an Amended Order on September 21, 1999. By the terms of the Board's Order, Respondent was reprimanded and was required to practice for one-year under the supervision of a licensed funeral director.

On May 23, 2000, the Board considered Mr. Newcomer's request that the limitation on his license be terminated. Based upon that request and upon evidence of Mr. Newcomer's full compliance with the terms and conditions on his license,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all the limitations on the license of Daniel L. Newcomer to practice as a funeral director in Wisconsin are lifted and he is restored to full licensure.
