On March 25, 1999, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited to require that within one year from the date of the board's Order, he complete 30 hours of Category 1 continuing medical education courses in the evaluation of patients presenting with acute neurological events.

At its meeting of March 23, 2000, the board considered Dr. Patel's request for a six month extension in the deadline for completing the 5½ hours of continuing education still remaining, and the board granted that request.

On August 24, 2000, the board considered evidence of Dr. Patel's having completed the required continuing education. Based upon that evidence, the board orders as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Dilip Patel. M.D., are terminated, and Dr. Patel is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
