ORDER

SUSPENDING LICENSE

On April 5, 1999, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order. Ms. Ivy was ordered to pay a forfeiture of \$600.00 in installments, with the final payment due by October 15, 1999. The order contained the following provision:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Rose Ann Ivy fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the manager license of Ms. Ivy (#17637) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

According to information received by the board from department monitor Ted Nehring, Ms. Ivy had not paid the forfeiture as of April 3, 2000. Mr. Nehring spoke to Ms. Ivy in December and on December 15, 1999, sent a letter to Ms. Ivy requesting payment. On January 18, 2000, Mr. Nehring sent Ms. Ivy a letter informing her that "Effective the date of this letter, the manager license (#17637) of Rose Ann Ivy is suspended."

IT IS ORDERED that manager license #17637 issued to Rose Ann Ivy is suspended as of January 18, 2000. Any practice of barbering and cosmetology or use of a manager's license by Rose Ann Ivy after January 18, 2000 will be considered operation without a license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rose Ann Ivy shall return her manager's license to the department monitor, Ted Nehring, Department of Regulation and Licensing, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708, within ten days after the date of this order (below) or be subject to further discipline.

This suspension will be lifted upon payment of the required forfeiture.
