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ORDER ACCEPTING SURRENDER

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On July 21, 1999, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period, with provision for successive three-month stays of the suspension conditioned upon compliance with certain conditions and limitations on the license. Among these were that respondent participate in a recognized program for the treatment of chemical dependency, that she participate in psychotherapy a once weekly, and that she participate in program of random witnessed monitoring for controlled substances and alcohol in her blood or urine on a frequency of not less than once per week.

On March 3, 2000, the board considered Ms. Sonsalla's letter of February 3, 2000, by which she expresses her desire to voluntarily surrender her license, based upon her financial inability to comply. Based upon that request, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the voluntary surrender of the license of Lisa Sonsalla, LPN, to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin be, and hereby is, accepted.
