MODIFICATION OF ORDER

On September 14, 1999, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board issued a *Final Decision and Order* in the above-captioned matter. Among the terms and conditions set forth in the board's order was that respondent was required to contract with the Institute for Safe Medication Practices, or a similar organization acceptable to the board (which acceptance shall not be unreasonably withheld), to conduct a full on-site evaluation of all of respondent's operations, for the purpose of, within 120 days of the date of the *Final Decision and Order*, respondent submitting to the board and implementing an operations policy satisfactory to the board, which is designed to prevent medication errors. On February 8, 2000, the board considered a request from respondent for a sixty (60) day extension to complete an on-site evaluation. The board determined that the request should be granted.

Based upon the foregoing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the respondent is granted a sixty (60) day extension from and including February 8, 2000 within which to have completed an on-site evaluation under the terms and conditions required by the September 14, 1999, *Final Decision and Order*.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that in all other respects, the previous September 14, 1999, *Final Decision and Order* of the board in this matter shall remain in full force and effect.
