On September 17, 1999, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, Ms. Ho's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that within six months of the date of the Order, she complete 18 hours of continuing education in the areas of stress management and nursing ethics. On January 6, 2000, the board considered Ms. Ho's request that the deadline for completing the required continuing education be extended to June 17, 2000. The board granted that request by its Order dated January 18, 2000.

On September 1, 2000, the board considered Ms. Ho's request for reinstatement to full licensure. Based upon that request, and upon evidence of Ms. Ho's having complied with the board's Order, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Pamela S. Ho, RN, are terminated, and Ms. Ho is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
