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The Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter on September 17, 1999. By the terms of the board's Order, Ms. Conard's license was suspended for an indefinite period, and the suspension was stayed for a period of three months, with provision for consecutive three month stays conditioned upon compliance with certain conditions and limitations on the license. respondent was required to enroll and continue successful participation in all components of a drug and alcohol treatment program at a treatment facility acceptable to the Board; participate in individual and/or group therapy sessions; attend Narcotics Anonymous and/or Alcoholic Anonymous meetings or an equivalent program for recovering professionals not less than once per week; and submit to screens for alcohol and controlled substances not less than once per week.

On November 3, 2000, the board considered Ms. Conard's request for a further three month stay of the suspension of her license, and her further request that the frequency of required urine screens be reduced. Based upon Ms. Conard's requests, and upon other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Sue Anne Conard, R.N., is hereby stayed for a further period of three months.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the number of required urine screens is hereby reduced from one per week to two per month.
