ORDER REINSTATING FULL LICENSURE

On September 23, 1999, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, Dr. Rusch's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited to require that he take and satisfactorily pass a 40 hour course in the proper prescribing of controlled substances.

On February 24, 2000, the board considered evidence of Dr. Rusch's having fulfilled the requirements under his limited license. Accordingly,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of James R. Rusch, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin are terminated, and Dr. Rusch is reinstated to full licensure.
