On September 6, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board reviewed a letter from Vali Kiaie, D.D.S., in which he requested permission from the Board to apply for his DEA registration, as provided in the Board's *Final Decision and Order* dated November 3, 1999.

Based upon the Board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Vali Kiaie, D.D.S., may apply to the DEA for registration. Said application shall be limited to a request for dispensing only Schedule IV and V controlled substances, as defined by the Uniform Controlled Substances Act contained in Chapter 961 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Vali Kiaie's license to practice dentistry is LIMITED in that he may only prescribe Schedule IV and V controlled substances to patients, unless otherwise ordered by the Board.
