ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

On November 5, 1999, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require in part that within six months of the date of the Order, she complete an approved course in nursing ethics.

On March 6, 2000, the board considered Ms. Levelius' petition for an extension of time in which to complete the required coursework. Based upon Ms. Levelius' petition, and upon other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that paragraph 2.a. of the board's order in this matter is hereby modified to require that Ms. Levelius certify to the board the successful completion of an approved course of training in nursing ethics by December 31, 2000. By September 1, 2000, Ms. Levelius shall submit to the board or its designee an outline of the required training for approval.
