On November 8, 2000, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Andrew P. Rice, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated September 21, 1999, for a reduction in the number of monthly urine screens as required by the *Order*, and to be permitted to act as a pharmacist in charge.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Andrew P. Rice, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #9594 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the number of monthly urine screens as required by the *Order* is reduced to six (6), and that Rice may work eight (8) hours per week as a pharmacist-in-charge with the restriction that he may not open or close the pharmacy.
