ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

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On November 7, 1999, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited to require, among other conditions, that Dr. Kruse complete within one year of the date of the Order a 40 hour course in prescribing controlled substances, and an educational program established through the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine on medical recordkeeping.

On December 20, the board considered evidence that Dr. Kruse has satisfactorily completed the controlled substance prescribing course. The board also considered a letter from Thomas C. Meyer, M.D., of the medical school, indicating that Dr. Kruse has made satisfactory progress in her educational program, has completed approximately one-half of the educational program, and is scheduled to complete it in April or May. Based upon this information, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the deadline for completing the educational program required by the board's Order of November 7, 1999, is hereby extended to July 1, 2001.
