On March 3, 2000, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period, with provision for successive three-month stays of the suspension conditioned upon compliance with certain conditions and limitations on the license. Among these were that respondent participate in a recognized program for the treatment of chemical dependency, that she participate in psychotherapy a minimum of once each month, and that she participate in program of random witnessed monitoring for controlled substances and alcohol in her blood or urine on a frequency of not less than twice per month.

By letter dated May 24, 2000, respondent requested a further three month stay of the suspension of her license. The board considered the request at its meeting of September 1, 2000, and orders as follows:

#### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Janine M. Clavey, RN, is hereby stayed for a further period of three months.
