FULL LICENSURE

On July 27, 1999, Ms. Chase filed her application for a license to practice as a practical nurse in the State of Wisconsin. Because Ms. Chase indicated on her application that she had an arrest record related to abuse of alcohol, she was asked to appear before the board for oral interview in connection with her application. Ms. Chase appeared before the board at its meeting of November 5, 1999, and the board considered the application on that date. Thereafter, the board and Ms. Chase entered into a Stipulation, by which the Board of Nursing (board) agreed to grant, and Ms. Chase agreed to accept, a limited license to practice nursing in the State of Wisconsin. The term of the limitation was for one year, and the limitation required that Ms. Chase arrange for quarterly work reports to be submitted by her employer.

On February 2, 2001, the board considered evidence of satisfactory compliance with the terms of Ms. Chase's limited license for the required period. Accordingly, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Katherine L. Chase to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Chase is hereby granted full licensure.
