On April 26, 1999, 1999, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent was a granted a limited license imposing a number of conditions and limitations on the license. Among other conditions, Dr. Dehner was required to enroll and successfully participate in a drug and alcohol treatment program satisfactory to the board, and to submit to drug and alcohol screens on a four times per month basis.

Pursuant to the board's Order, Dr. Dehner appeared before the board on May 16, 2001, for his annual appearance. Based upon that appearance, and other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

## **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the board's Final Decision and Order in this matter dated April 26, 1999, is hereby modified to decrease the number of required urine screens from four per month to two per month.
