The State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, having considered the record in the above captioned matter, makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On February 14, 2001, the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing (department) issued an Order Adopting Stipulation granting a limited private security permit registration to Leonard K. Brown. Among other things, the Order Adopting Stipulation limits the registration of Leonard K. Brown by requiring that Leonard K. Brown file quarterly reports with the Department providing information concerning his employment, arrest and conviction record and job performance. Paragraph 2. of the Order Adopting Stipulation requires that quarterly reports be filed within 5 days after the following dates: June 1, 2001; September 1, 2001; December 1, 2001 and March 1, 2002. A copy of the Order Adopting Stipulation is annexed hereto.

2. The Order Adopting Stipulation (Paragraph 4) also states that Applicant Brown may not transfer to another licensed private detective agency and perform activities under his private security permit without permission, in advance, from the Department of Regulation and Licensing, and unless the new employer agrees, in writing, that the terms of this limitation will be complied with and that the new employer will cooperate with the applicant in the preparation and submittal to the department of the required reports..

3. The Order Adopting Stipulation further provides that the failure of Leonard K. Brown to comply with the limitation in the Order Adopting Stipulation shall result in the revocation of his limited private security permit without further notice or hearing or other proceedings.

4. Marlene Meyer is an employee of the Department whose job title is "Department Monitor" and whose responsibilities include receiving and monitoring reports from credential holders who hold a limited credential and who are required to file reports with the Department.

5. On or about September 6, 2001, Marlene Meyer wrote to Leonard K. Brown, stating in part that: "To date, you have failed to have the following filed with the Division of Enforcement in your behalf:

The required quarterly statement from your employer (Metropolitan Special Protection LLC) evaluating your performance.

Please submit the requested reports by September 16, 2001. Failure to return the reports will cause this matter to be referred to the Division of Enforcement as a possible violation of the Board order."

6. As of the date of this order, Leonard K. Brown has not filed the reports required by the Order Adopting Stipulation.

7. Leonard K. Brown transferred to another licensed private detective agency without permission, in advance, from the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The failure of Leonard K. Brown to file reports as required by the Department's Order and described in the Findings of Fact, above, constitutes a failure to comply with the terms of the limitation in the Order Adopting Stipulation.

2. Leonard K. Brown transferring to another licensed private detective agency without permission, in advance, from the Department of Regulation and Licensing as required by the Department's Order and described in the Findings of Fact, above, constitutes a failure to comply with the terms of the limitation in the Order Adopting Stipulation.

3. The State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction in this proceeding under Chapter 440, Stats., and the provisions in the Order Adopting Stipulation.

4. The State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has authority to issue the following Order under Chapter 440, Stats., and the provisions in the Order Adopting Stipulation.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Limited Private Security Permit of Leonard K. Brown (license #4642) and the Firearms Certification (license # 1139)is REVOKED. Applicant Leonard K. Brown shall cease and desist from acting as a private security person, from engaging in private security activities in Wisconsin or to carry a firearm for a private detective agency.
