On July 10, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Mark G. Anderson, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated August 9, 2000, and that Mr. Anderson be allowed to work additional hours as a pharmacist in charge. Also appearing to present testimony and argument in support of the petition were Mr. Anderson and his attorney Hal Harlowe.
