On March 14, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Paul L. Nelson, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension of his license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order ("Order")* dated March 15, 2000, and a request that he be allowed to function as a pharmacist in charge for his employer, that his urine screens be reduced to six times per month and that his therapy meetings be reduced to once per month.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Paul L. Nelson, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8294 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. The request that Nelson be allowed to act as a pharmacist in charge is granted, and he may work as a pharmacist in charge for one hour per day but may not open or close the pharmacy. The request for a reduction in the number of random urine screens to six times per month is granted. The request for a reduction in the number of therapy meetings is denied.
