On December 11, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Paul L. Nelson, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension of his license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order ("Order")* dated March 15, 2000, and a request that he be allowed to change the frequency of his therapy sessions to once per month and be allowed to act as a pharmacist in charge for more than eight (8) hours per week.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Paul L. Nelson, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8294 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for modification of the *Order* to work additional hours per week as a pharmacist in charge is granted, for a total of twelve (12) hours per week. Nelson may open and close the pharmacy but may not do so consecutively.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to change the frequency of therapy sessions to once per month, is granted.
