On December 11, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Thomas M. Triscari, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension of his license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated May 17, 2000, and a request to modify the required weekly individual/group therapy sessions as required by paragraph 2b(2) of the *Order* to once per month individual sessions. Also requested was an increase in the hours worked as a pharmacist in charge to blocks of approximately 4 or 5 hours per week for a total of 20 per month. The respondent is currently practicing under a modification order dated June 13, 2001, allowing work as a pharmacist in charge for one hour per day with a maximum of four hours per week, with the ability to open and close the pharmacy. Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Thomas M. Triscari, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #10029 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for modification of the required weekly group therapy sessions to individual sessions to once per month is denied, however a modification for two times per month is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for an increase in the number of hours worked as a pharmacist in charge to eight (8) hours per week is GRANTED.
