ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent

On June 22, 2000, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was suspended, and the suspension was stayed for a period of three months. The Order provided for additional stays of the suspension conditioned upon compliance with limitations on the license. These included requirements that Dr. Sparr participate in a drug treatment program and submit to urine screens for alcohol and controlled substances a minimum of twice per week. One of the controlled substances required to be screened for is fentanyl.

On August 24, 2000, the board considered Dr. Sparr's request that fentanyl be dropped from the screening panel based on the fact that the laboratory in Arizona which is analyzing the urine samples does not normally test for fentanyl, and that adding the test substantially increases the cost of the screen. The board granted the request.

On January 17, 2001, the board granted Dr. Sparr's request for a further three month stay of the suspension of his license. Because of circumstances beyond his control, Dr. Sparr became unable to comply with the terms of his limited license, and he therefore requested that the stay of suspension of his license be terminated.

On July 18, 2001, Dr. Sparr appeared before the board with Attorney Randall Arnold, to request reinstatement of the stay of suspension of his license. Based upon that request, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Kenneth E. Sparr, M.D., is hereby stayed for a further period of three months. Dr. Sparr may apply for further three month stays of the suspension, which shall be granted upon submission of satisfactory evidence of having fully complied with the limitations on his license during the preceding three month period.
