ORDER GRANTING

FULL LICENSURE

On September 1, 2000, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for a period of three months. The suspension was stayed conditioned upon completion of continuing education, and submission of satisfactory written quarterly work reports prepared by her employer. The Order provided that upon successful compliance with the terms and conditions, the board would grant respondent's petition for a return to full licensure.

On October 4, 2001, the board considered respondent's petition for return to full licensure. Based upon the entire record in this matter, including documentation of respondent's full compliance with the terms and conditions of her limited license, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of, Lynn C. Lambright, R.N., to practice professional nursing in the State of Wisconsin, as imposed by the board's Final Decision and Order in this matter dated September 1, 2000, be, and hereby are, terminated, and Ms. Lambright is hereby returned to full licensure.
