ORDER DENYING STAY

Respondent

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On November 3, 2000, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period, with provision for successive three-month stays of the suspension conditioned upon compliance with certain conditions and limitations on the license. Among these were that respondent participate in a recognized program for the treatment of chemical dependency, that she participate in therapy a minimum of four times each month, and that she participate in program of random witnessed monitoring for controlled substances and alcohol in her blood or urine on a frequency of not less than once per week.

By letter dated February 9, 2001, respondent requested that the stay of the suspension of her license be renewed, and the board considered the request at its meeting of March 1, 2001. The board granted the stay.

On March 1, 2001, and again on June 1, 2001, the board granted Ms. Fenner's request for further three month stays of the suspension.

On September 6, 2001, the board considered Ms. Fenner's request for a further three month stay of the suspension of her license. The board also considered evidence of numerous violations by Ms. Fenner of the requirements of her limited license. Based upon that evidence, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Ms. Fenner's request for a further three month stay of the suspension of her license is denied, and Ms. Fenner's license is suspended effective immediately.
