On December 11, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Jeffrey C. Verzal, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension of his license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("*Order*") dated November 8, 2000, and a request to be allowed to work as a pharmacist-in-charge for a six (6) hour period at an undisclosed location that ships peritoneal solutions to home care patients. No controlled substances are on the premises.

Based upon the board's review of the petition and supporting documentation,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Jeffrey C. Verzal, R.Ph., is granted a one month stay of the suspension of license #8377 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for modification of the *Order* to allow practice as a pharmacist in charge is denied.
