On November 14, 2000, the Board issued its *Final Decision and Order* in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the Board's Order, Respondents' licenses were limited, and they were required to implement, *inter alia*, an ordered system of bookkeeping and billing. The Order also provided that upon a showing by Respondents that they had successfully implemented such a system that they would be entitled to the return of their full licenses.

On July 17, 2001, the Board considered the reports submitted by the Roger G. Roth Tax & Accounting Service firm with respect to the Respondent's billing and accounting practices. Accordingly, based upon the evidence that the Respondents are in full compliance with the terms and conditions on their licenses,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all the limitations on the license of Jeffrey D. Ward to practice as a funeral director in Wisconsin are lifted, and he is restored to full licensure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all the limitations on the license of the Bruni, Nygaard, Ward Funeral Home are lifted and that the funeral establishment is hereby restored to full licensure.
