ORDER CONFIRMING THE  
UNLIMITED LICENSE

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On November 15, 2000, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, Dr. Gondi's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited to require in part that within six months of the date of the Order, Dr. Gondi complete a 10 hour independent study program addressing appropriate recordkeeping practices for anesthesiologists.

On February 21, 2001, the board considered Dr. Gondi's request for an extension in the time for completing the program due to delays in receiving the program materials. The board extended the deadline to May 31, 2001.

Dr. Gondi completed the required program within the time provided, and the limitation was removed from his license at that time. The only remaining requirement was that he submit to an audit of his recordkeeping, which was completed by May 22, 2001. On July 18, 2001, the board considered evidence that Dr. Gondi's recordkeeping was satisfactory, and the board hereby confirms that Dr. Gondi now has a full, unencumbered license to practice medicine and surgery.
