ORDER REINSTATING

FULL LICENSURE

On January 4, 2001, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that within six months of the date of the Order, she complete not less than 12 hours of therapy and training in anger and stress management, and at least six hours of training in patient management.

On June 1, 2001, the board considered Ms. Boyer's request for an extension in the deadline for completing the required training to September 4, 2001, and granted that request.

On September 6, 2001, the board considered evidence of Ms. Boyer's having fulfilled the requirements of her limited license. Based on that evidence, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Cheryl A. Boyer, LPN, to practice as a practical nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Boyer is reinstated to full licensure.
