**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. John A. Ray, RN (DOB 04/05/46), is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin to practice as a registered nurse (license #30-88862). This license was first granted to Mr. Ray on August 21, 1984.
2. Respondent's latest address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 21877 County Hwy W, Kendall, WI 54638.
3. Respondent consents to the issuance of the following Conclusions of Law and Order in resolution of the pending investigation (00 NUR 192) referenced herein.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to ch. 441.07, Stats.
2. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation, pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Stats.

**ORDER**

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Board of Nursing ACCEPTS the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of the license of John A. Ray (#30-88862) to practice as a Registered nurse in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this surrender is PERMANENT and Mr. Ray will not be allowed to reapply for Wisconsin licensure at anytime in the future.
