ORDER MODIFYING

THE LIMITED LICENSE

On February 21, 2001, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited to require that he complete a risk management program developed and administered by the U.W. School of Medicine, Continuing Education Department.

On May 16, 2001, the board considered Dr. London's request, and the request of Dr. Tom Meyer, Director of the Continuing Education Department, that the prescribed program be restructured consistent with Dr. London's current practice setting. The restructured program, as set forth in Dr. Meyer's letter of April 6, 2001, would have as its objective the opportunity for Dr. London to become the risk management expert in his current practice situation.

Based upon Dr. London's request, and other information of record herein, it is ordered as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the board's Final Decision and Order in this matter dated February 21, 2001, is hereby modified to permit the risk management program to be restructured consistent with the description set forth in Dr. Meyer's letter of April 6, 2001, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
