The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board received a Stipulation submitted by the parties to the above-captioned matter. The Stipulation, a copy of which is attached hereto, was executed by Audra Yentz, P.A., personally on her own behalf, and by Claudia Berry Miran, attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement. Based upon the Stipulation of the parties, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Audra Yentz, P.A. was born May 10, 1968. Ms. Yentz's latest address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 6683 Glenview Road, DeForest, WI 53532.
2. Ms. Yentz is licensed to practice in the state of Wisconsin as a physician assistant pursuant to license #652. This license was first granted on February 19, 1992.
3. On October 31, 1999, Ms. Yentz's Wisconsin physician assistant registration expired, and Ms. Yentz did not renew her registration until August 4, 2000. During that period of time, Ms. Yentz continued to work in Wisconsin as a physician assistant.
4. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Yentz consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to § 448.03 (1) (b), Stats.
2. The Medical Examining Board has authority to enter into this stipulated resolution without an evidentiary hearing pursuant to § 227.44 (5), Stats.

3. The Conduct described in paragraph 3 in the Findings of Fact constitutes unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Adm. Code § MED 10.02 (2) (a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

- 1. Audra Yentz, P.A. is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 2. Ms. Yentz shall, within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, pay partial costs of this proceeding in the amount of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

- 3. The pending investigation, 00 MED 156, shall be, and hereby is, closed without further proceedings.
- 4. Pursuant to § 448.02 (4), Stats., if the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board determines that there is probable cause to believe that Ms. Yentz has violated the terms of this Final Decision and Order, the Board may order that the license of Ms. Yentz to practice as a physician assistant in the State of Wisconsin be summarily suspended pending investigation of the alleged violation.

The rights of a party aggrieved by this Final Decision and Order to petition the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board for rehearing and to petition for judicial review are set forth in the attached "Notice of Appeal Information."

This Order shall become effective on the date of its signing.
