The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision in this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Tammy Lou Beier (DOB 12/09/1967) is licensed by the Board of Nursing as a licensed practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin [license #301985]. This license was first granted on 03/05/1999.
- 2. Respondent's last address reported to the Department of Regulation and Licensing is PO Box 1831, Fond du Lac, WI 54936.

- 3. On August 10, 2000, Respondent was found guilty of four [4] counts of violation of sec. 948.03(4)(b), Wis. Stats. [Felony Child Abuse/ Failure to Prevent Bodily Harm]; one [1] count of violation of sec. 948.03(2)(b), Wis. Stats. [Felony Child Abuse/ Intentionally Causing Harm]; and six [6] counts of violation of sec. 943.21(1) Wis. Stats. [misdemeanor neglecting a child]. True and correct copies of the criminal complaint and judgment of conviction in this matter are attached to this Order as Exhibit A.
- 4. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to § 441.07, Stats.
- 2. The Board of Nursing has authority to enter into this stipulated resolution of this matter pursuant to § 227.44(5), Stats.
- 3. The conviction referred to above constitutes grounds for revocation of Respondent's license, pursuant to sec. 441.07(1), Wis. Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code § N7.04 (1) and (15).

#### **ORDER**

### NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

- 1. Tammy Lou Beier's license as a licensed practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. Respondent shall not reapply for a nursing license in Wisconsin.
- 2. Upon submission of acceptable evidence that the convictions referred to in this Order are overturned upon appeal, the Board shall grant a petition by Ms. Beier for an Order vacating this Final Decision and returning her Wisconsin Nursing License. Acceptable evidence shall consist of a certified copy of the judgment vacating the convictions against Ms. Beier. A return of licensure a) shall be granted when the order of reversal is permanent and not subject to further appeal; and b) shall be dependent upon payment of licensure fees and other renewal requirements.
