The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. John W. Zastrow, DC (D.O.B. 09/13/1965) is duly licensed as a chiropractor in the state of Wisconsin (license #3284). This license was first granted on 10/13/1995.
2. Dr. Zastrow's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board is S2840 Hwy. 13 N, Marshfield, WI 54449.
3. On exact dates unknown, but on several occasions in 1999, Dr. Zastrow performed chiropractic adjustments on animals without the direct supervision of a licensed veterinarian as required by Wis. Admin. Code §VE 7.02(5). Dr. Zastrow had obtained training in the care of animals in conjunction with his chiropractic education and was unaware of the requirement for direct supervision by a licensed veterinarian for work on animals in Wisconsin.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to sec. 446.03, Stats.
2. The Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation, pursuant to secs. 227.44(5) and 440.21, Stats.

3. The findings referred to in paragraphs 3, above, constitute a basis for disciplinary action against Respondent’s license to practice as a chiropractor in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to secs. 446.01(2), 446.03(5) and 453.05, Wis. Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code § Chir 6.02(4), 6.02(25) and VE 7.02(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

- 1. John W. Zastrow, DC is REPRIMANDED.
- 2. John W. Zastrow, DC shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing pay partial costs of this matter in the amount of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY dollars (\$150.00). Payment shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, made payable to the Department of Regulation and Licensing, and sent to:

- 3. In the event John W. Zastrow, DC fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the license of Dr. Zastrow (#3284) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Dr. Zastrow has complied with the terms of this Order.
- 4. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
