The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Deanna R. Finley, is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of a duly licensed barbering and cosmetology establishment in the State of Wisconsin, d/b/a under the trade name, Great Clips. Great Clips is located at 1428 E. Geneva Street, P.O. Box 196, Delavan, WI 53115, and is licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the State of Wisconsin (license #80-27027). Great Clip’s license was first granted on November 21, 1997.
2. As the owner of a licensed establishment, Deanna R. Finley was at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code, chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
3. On January 26, 2001, the Department conducted an inspection in regard to alleged sanitary violations involving

head lice and failure to have a licensed manager at the establishment. The investigators observed that the establishment did not have the required supply of disposable gloves and did not store loose hair clippings in a covered container. Further inspection revealed that the establishment did not have the blood protocol posted and clean disinfected contact equipment was not stored in a covered containers.

4. Finley informed the investigator that Nancy Barch is the manager of record for the establishment. Barch is a licensed manager, having license # 81-28619, which was first granted on February 16, 2001. Dana Albrecht was the previous manager. Albrecht is a licensed manager, having license # 81-25082, which was first granted on January 4, 1993.

5. Finley signed the order to correct the sanitary violations and post the blood protocol. The manager and owner were aware of the proper measures to be taken if a case of head lice is discovered. There was no evidence to substantiate sanitary violations in connection with the allegations of head lice.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in the paragraphs above, Deanna R. Finley, d/b/a Great Clips, has violated Wis. Admin. Code BC4.05(2), BC4.02(3a) and BC3.01(4) for failure to maintain sanitary premises.

By the conduct referred to in the paragraphs above, Deanna R. Finley, d/b/a Great Clips, has violated Wis. Admin. Code BC4.04(2) and BC2.06(2) by failing to provide disposable gloves.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Deanna R. Finley, d/b/a Great Clips shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of TWO HUNDRED dollars **(\$200.00)**. Payment shall be submitted within thirty (30) days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: **Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Department of Regulation and Licensing, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Deanna R. Finley fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Great Clips (#80-27027) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
