The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department Secretary. The Department Secretary has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department Secretary adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Paula Debuhr, [7335 Delaine Drive, Oak Creek, WI 53154] is not and was not at any time relevant to this action licensed to practice as a dental hygienist in the state of Wisconsin.
2. On exact dates unknown, but at least between September 20, 2000 and March 8, 2001, respondent engaged in the unlicensed practice of dental hygiene in Wisconsin.
3. Ms. Debuhr understands that she needs a license to practice as a dental hygienist in the state of Wisconsin. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Debuhr consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to sec. 440.21, Stats.
2. A license is required to practice dental hygiene in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to sec. 447.03(2), Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Respondent PAULA DEBUHR is ENJOINED and PROHIBITED as follows:

1. Respondent SHALL NOT PRACTICE OR OFFER TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE in the state of Wisconsin unless and UNTIL she obtains a license from the Dentistry Examining Board.
2. **Violation of the above-order may result in a forfeiture of up to \$10,000.00 for each offense, and each day of a continued violation constitutes a separate offense.**
3. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
