The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about February 14, 1997, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board issued Aaron Cunningham, 5457 North Long Island Drive, Milwaukee, WI 53209, an initial apprenticeship permit (permit #7395). The Department of Workforce Development canceled Mr. Cunningham's indenture for failure to attend school on June 1, 1998.
2. In October, 1999, Mr. Cunningham filed a petition for an extension of his barbering and cosmetology apprenticeship permit to allow him time to complete his theory training hours and to continue working following the first 22 months of his apprenticeship without completion of theory training.
3. In resolution of this matter, Mr. Cunningham consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to secs. 454.15(2) and 454.10(3), Stats. and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

the application of Aaron Cunningham for an extension of his barbering and cosmetology apprentice permit shall be granted, **subject to the following terms and conditions:**

Application

1. Mr. Cunningham shall arrange for the completion of all necessary paperwork for the activation of his apprenticeship permit with the Department of Workforce Development. *Mr. Cunningham may not commence work as an apprentice until the requirements of this paragraph are satisfied.*

Theory instruction.

2. Mr. Cunningham must maintain current enrollment in and uninterrupted attendance at an acceptable provider of theory instruction for barbering and cosmetology.

Reports.

3. During the time that Mr. Cunningham holds an apprenticeship permit he shall arrange for submission of the following reports **on at least a monthly basis:**

a) Current documentation of satisfactory enrollment in school; school attendance and progress in school; and

b) Current documentation of satisfactory work attendance and training.

4. All documentation [*including proof of enrollment, school attendance and work reports*] shall be submitted to Field Representative Hafeezah Ahmad, Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards, Department of Workforce Development, 819 N. 6th St., Room 516, Milwaukee, WI 53203; Tel. (414) 227-4973.

Permit.

5. The apprenticeship permit shall be issued for a maximum term of twenty-four (24) months.

Completion of training.

6. Immediately following completion of his theory and practical instruction, Mr. Cunningham shall contact Continental Testing [(800) 359-1313] to schedule his licensure examination and obtain a temporary permit. A temporary permit is required in order to continue practicing after theory and practical instruction is completed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT

IN THE EVENT THAT THE BOARD RECEIVES NOTIFICATION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT THAT AARON CUNNINGHAM HAS FAILED TO MAINTAIN SATISFACTORY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AND PROGRESS IN SCHOOL OR THAT MR. CUNNINGHAM HAS FAILED TO MAINTAIN SATISFACTORY WORK ATTENDANCE AND PARTICIPATION IN TRAINING, THE APPRENTICESHIP PERMIT GRANTED TO MR. CUNNINGHAM (#7395) **SHALL BE REVOKED**, WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE OR HEARING, AND MR. CUNNINGHAM MUST THEN IMMEDIATELY CEASE PRACTICING BARBERING AND COSMETOLOGY.

This Order shall become effective on the date of its signing.
