The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Parkside Styles, 300 Third Avenue, Stratford, WI 54484, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #29521). This license was first granted on December 21, 2000.
2. Jody Skrzypchak, 322 2nd Avenue, PO Box 94, Stratford, WI 54484, is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of Parkside Styles. As owner, Jody Skrzypchak was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
3. On or about May 31, 2001, inspection of Parkside Styles revealed that a portable cart contained hair clippings on the bottom of the storage drawers in the cart.
4. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3, above, Jody Skrzypchak, d/b/a Parkside Styles, violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §BC 4.01(1).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that

1. Respondent shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within thirty [30] days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935
- 2. In the event Jody Skrzypchak fails to timely pay the forfeiture set forth in ¶ 1 above, the establishment license of Parkside Styles (#29521) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.**
3. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
