ORDER DENYING PETITION

Respondent

On January 7, 2000, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that within 30 days of the date of the Order, she notify all affected employers and insurers of the period during which she worked without a current registration, and that she submit proof to the board of having conducted an in-service on the subject of the importance of maintaining current licensure.

On January 5, 2001, the board considered Ms. Cressy's request that she be granted a full license. Based upon that request, and other information of record herein, including lack of evidence that she has complied with the requirement that she present an in-service on the importance of maintaining current licensure, board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Ms. Cressy's request for restoration of full licensure is denied. She may again present her request after submission of evidence satisfactory to the board that she has complied with the requirement that she present an in-service on the importance of maintaining current licensure.
