The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Chad B. Rindy, R.Ph. (d.o.b. 1/1/69), is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a registered pharmacist licensed in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #12085, originally granted on 4/6/94.
2. On April 18, 2000, respondent signed his license renewal form which contained the following statement: "I have completed 30 hours of ACPE-approved continuing education beginning June 1, 1998 and ending May 31, 2000, and have or will have evidence of this certification by the providing institution, which I will furnish to the Pharmacy Examining Board upon request." Following a request from an investigator for the Board, respondent failed to produce evidence that he had completed 30 hours of continuing education during the 1998-2000 biennium. Respondent has produced evidence of completion of 18 hours of continuing education for that biennium.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- A. The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to §450.10, Wis. Stats. and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to §227.44(5), Wis. Stats.
- B. The conduct described in paragraph 2, above, violated §§450.085 and 450.10(1)(a)2., Wis. Stats. Such conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct within the meaning of the Code and statutes

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that respondent, Chad B. Rindy, R.Ph., is REPRIMANDED for his unprofessional conduct in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that respondent shall, within 90 days, submit evidence that he has completed 12 hours of ACPE-approved continuing education. None of these hours shall be submitted or counted as hours of continuing education for the 2000-2002 biennium.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that respondent shall FORFEIT \$600, representing \$50 per hour for which he did not have proof of completion, to be paid within 60 days of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that respondent shall pay COSTS in this matter in the amount of \$400, within 60 days of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that an investigator of the department shall observe the practice of pharmacy at respondent's practice location, without advance notice to respondent, at a time convenient to the department, but no less than six nor more than twelve months from the date of this Order. Respondent shall cooperate by furnishing respondent's work schedule upon request.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to §227.51(3), Wis. Stats., and ch. RL 6, Wis. Adm. Code, if the Board determines that there is probable cause to believe that respondent has violated any term of this Final Decision and Order, the Board may order that the license of respondent be summarily suspended pending investigation of the alleged violation.
