The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

In the interest of resolving this matter, Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations against her and consents to the entry of the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Tari L. Gutbrod (D.O.B. 09/28/1952) is duly licensed as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license #112492). This license was first granted on 03/24/1993.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 116 East Hickey Avenue, Tomahawk, WI 54487. Respondent's latest address is 16802 Park Place Street, Apartment 2, Eagle River, AK 99577-7859.
3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent worked as a registered nurse at Riverview Rehabilitation Care Center, 428 North 6th Street, Tomahawk, Wisconsin.
4. On or about October 6, 1999 at approximately 7:30 p.m. Respondent delegated administration of medications for a resident assigned to her care to a nursing assistant who was not legally authorized to administer

medications.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to sec. 441.07, Stats.
2. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation, pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Stats.
3. By the conduct described above, Tari L. Gutbrod is subject to disciplinary action against her Wisconsin nursing license, pursuant to sec. 441.07(1), Wis. Stats., and Wis. Admin. Code § N7.03(1)(a)(3) and N7.04(15).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Tari L. Gutbrod RN (license #112492) is REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Wisconsin nursing license of Tari L. Gutbrod (license #112492) is LIMITED as follows:

Education

1. Within nine [9] months from the date of this Order, Respondent shall submit documentation acceptable to the Board of successful completion of at least six (6) hours of continuing education or other training acceptable to the Board in the areas of medication administration and nursing delegation. To be acceptable, the course or training shall be pre-approved by a member or designated agent of the Board of Nursing. Acceptable documentation shall include certification from the sponsoring organization as well as a statement signed by Respondent verifying her attendance and completion of course requirements.

2. The Department Monitor is the individual designated by the Board as its agent to coordinate compliance with the terms of this Order, including receiving reports and coordinating all requests or approval of education or other petitions. The Department Monitor may be reached as follows:

Termination of Limitations

3. Upon receipt of acceptable documentation of timely completion of the continuing education required above, Respondent's license shall be restored to full and unrestricted status.

SUMMARY SUSPENSION

4. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may in addition be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license pursuant to the procedures set forth in Wis. Admin. Code RL Ch. 6. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

5. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
