The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Stacey Nichelle Bernard, R.Ph. (d.o.b. 3-31-68), is a registered pharmacist licensed in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #13407, originally granted on 6/18/01. Respondent is also licensed to practice in Texas and Louisiana, and was so licensed at all times set forth in paragraph 2, below.
2. On 6/7/99, respondent began employment at St. Joseph's Hospital Pharmacy, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, as a pharmacist, and practiced pharmacy there until approximately 7/7/00.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- A. The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to §450.10, Wis. Stats. and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to §227.44(5), Wis. Stats.
- B. The conduct described in paragraph 2, above, violated § Phar 10.02(19), Wis. Adm. Code. Such conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct within the meaning of the Code and statutes

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that respondent, Stacey N. Bernard, R.Ph., is REPRIMANDED, for her unprofessional conduct in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that respondent shall submit evidence of 30 hours of ACPE-approved continuing education which has been completed after 6/1/98, within 60 days of this Order. None of these hours shall be submitted or counted as hours of continuing education for the 2000-2002 biennium.
