The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Lillie M. Brown, 431 Olympian Boulevard, Apt. 5, Beloit, WI 53511, is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a barbering or cosmetology manager (license #5948). This license was first granted on 11/02/1956.
2. At all times relevant to this action Lillie M. Brown served as the barbering and cosmetology manager of Aquas Beauty Supplies, a licensed barbering and cosmetology establishment [946 Wisconsin Avenue, Beloit, WI 53511; license # 29593]. As manager, Ms. Brown was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2 and 3.
3. On exact dates unknown, but at least in May and June 2001, Tara Smith worked as a barber and cosmetologist at Aquas Beauty Supplies. Ms. Smith did not possess a license to practice barbering and cosmetology in Wisconsin at that time.
4. In resolution of this matter, Lillie M. Brown consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3, above, Lillie M. Brown violated secs. 454.04(1)(a), 454.10(1) and 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.04(1) and BC 2.07.

## ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that

1. Ms. Brown shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a FORFEITURE of ONE THOUSAND dollars (\$1,000.00). Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

2. Payment shall be submitted by at least the following schedule:

**2. In the event Lillie M. Brown fails to timely pay the forfeiture set forth in ¶ 1 above, her manager license (#5948) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.**
