The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Dao. V. Nguyen (DOB November 11, 1963) of 1127 Glades Drive, Altoona, WI 54720, is duly licensed as a manicurist in the state of Wisconsin (license #4667). This license was first granted on September 10, 2001.
2. Lees Nails, 4800 Golf Road, Eau Claire, WI 54701 is duly licensed as a manicuring establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #1742). This license was first granted on September 12, 2001.
3. On exact dates unknown, but at least on August 22, 2001, Dao V. Nguyen was employed at Lees Nails to provide manicuring services to the public. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Nguyen hold a valid and current Wisconsin manicurist license.
4. In resolution of this matter, Mr. Nguyen consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3, above, Dao V. Nguyen, violated sec. 454.04(1)(d), Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that

1. Dao V. Nguyen, shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within 30 days from the effective date of this Order.

2. Payment shall be made by ***certified check or money order***, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Dao V. Nguyen fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the manicurist license of Respondent (#4667) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
