On May 15, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by John R. Schmitt, R.Ph., to reinstate a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("*Order*") dated August 13, 1997, and that the number of monthly urine screens be reduced to six, and that the weekly counseling sessions be modified to the amount requested by his counselor based on what the counselor considered necessary.

Based upon the board's review of the documentation submitted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that John R. Schmitt, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license #8852 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the requests for the modification of the *Order* are denied.
