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DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS AGAINST

ORDER GRANTING STAY

On January 19, 2000, the board considered Dr. Colburn's initial request for a three month stay of the suspension of his license. By its Order dated January 26, 2000, the board granted that request.

On July 19, 2000, the board considered evidence that there had been nothing received by the board's monitor indicating that any of the requirements of the limited license had been met. The board therefore lifted the stay on that date.

On October 18, 2000, the board considered Dr. Colburn's request that the number of required urine screens be reduced from one per week to one every two weeks, consistent with the requirement imposed by the Michigan Health Professional Recovery Corporation program in which Dr. Colburn is participating. The board granted the request by its Order dated October 25, 2000.

On April 18, the board considered Dr. Colburn's request for a further three month stay of the suspension. Based upon that request, and upon other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Michael D. Colburn, M.D., is hereby stayed for a further period of three months.
