SUSPENSION AND MODIFICATION

On July 10, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., for a three month stay of suspension as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated August 12, 1998, and that the required monthly urine screens currently set at six (6) be reduced to (4) four, and that Moon be allowed to practice as a pharmacist in charge in an amount increased from the current 16 allotted hours per week to an amount as deemed appropriate by the board.

Based upon the board's review:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the petition of Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., for a three month stay of suspension of license number 10536 is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the request for a reduction in urine screens is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the request for to be allowed to practice as a pharmacist in charge in an amount increased from the current 16 allotted hours per week, is granted for an additional 8 hours for a total of 24 hours per week.
