On May 15, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("*Order*") dated December 8, 1998, LS 9812084 PHM.

Based upon the board's review and consideration of the submitted documentation the board finds that one of the petitioner's urine screens has tested positive for benzodiazepines on 4-19-2001, and that the drug screen results of petitioner have not been provided to petitioner's treatment provider. Thereupon, the board finds the petitioner is not in compliance with the *Order*.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., is denied a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8239 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.
